- 34,000 records/7000 full-text items
- Metadata entry – Bibliographic Services
- Internally hosted EPrints
- Publications feeds on LSE Experts profiles
- Version 3.3.10

Before the EPrints REF2014 Plugin

- Needed a tool to import publication data to HEFCE for REF
- No CRIS
- Mini-REF – Jan 2011 & Jun 2012
- Running reports directly from the database



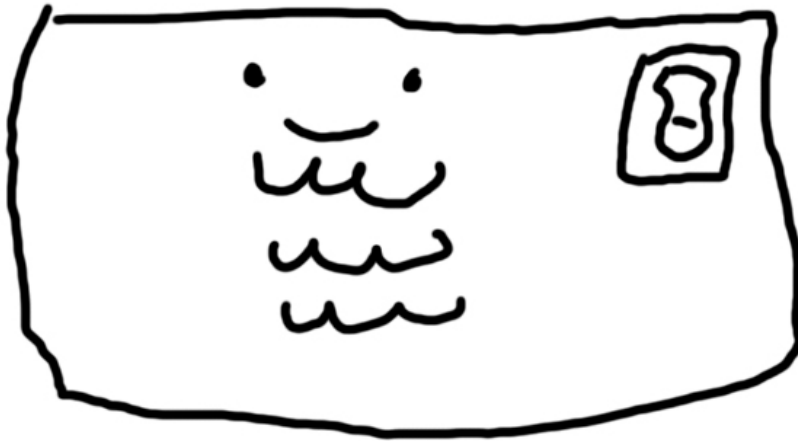
