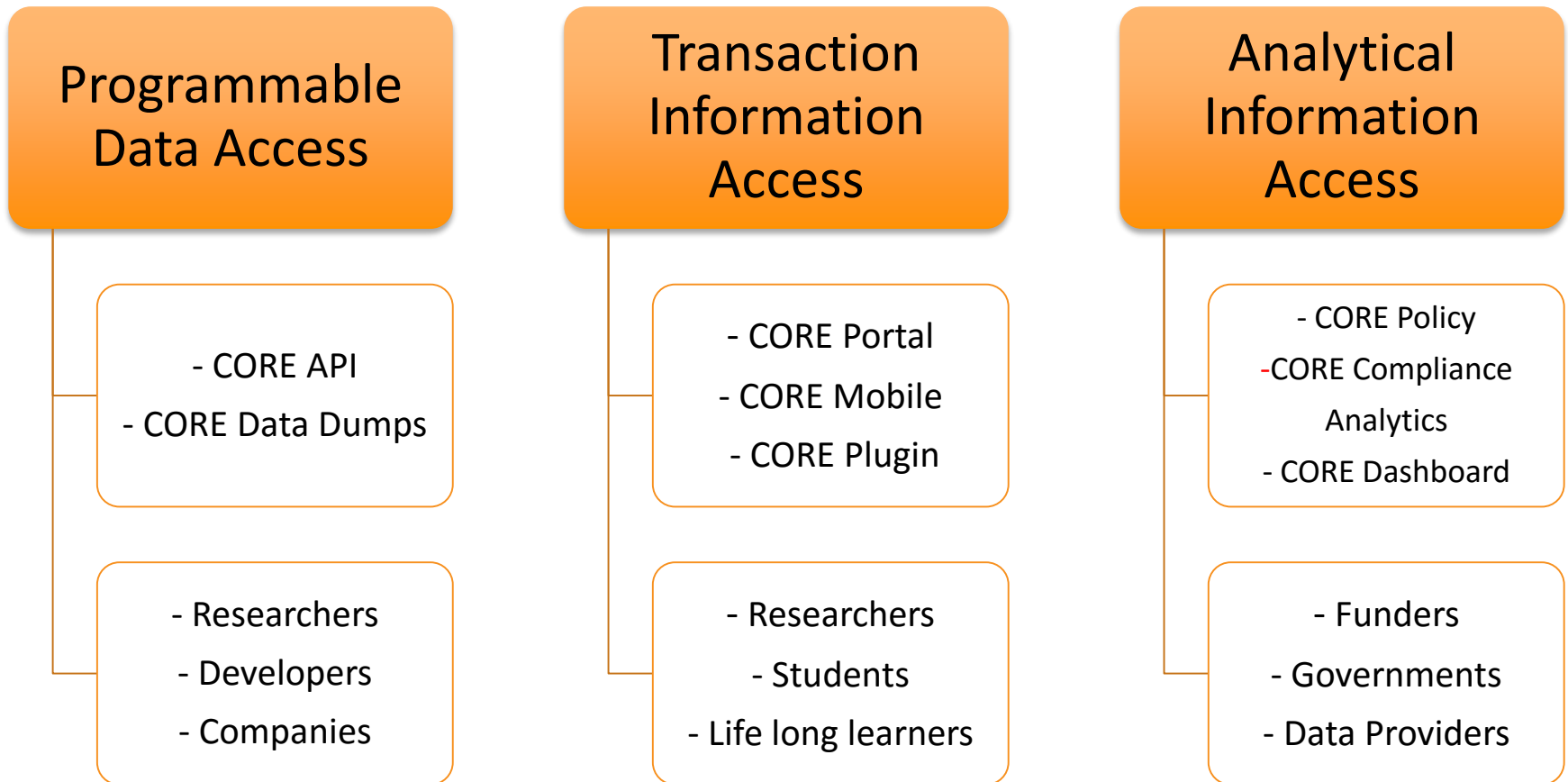

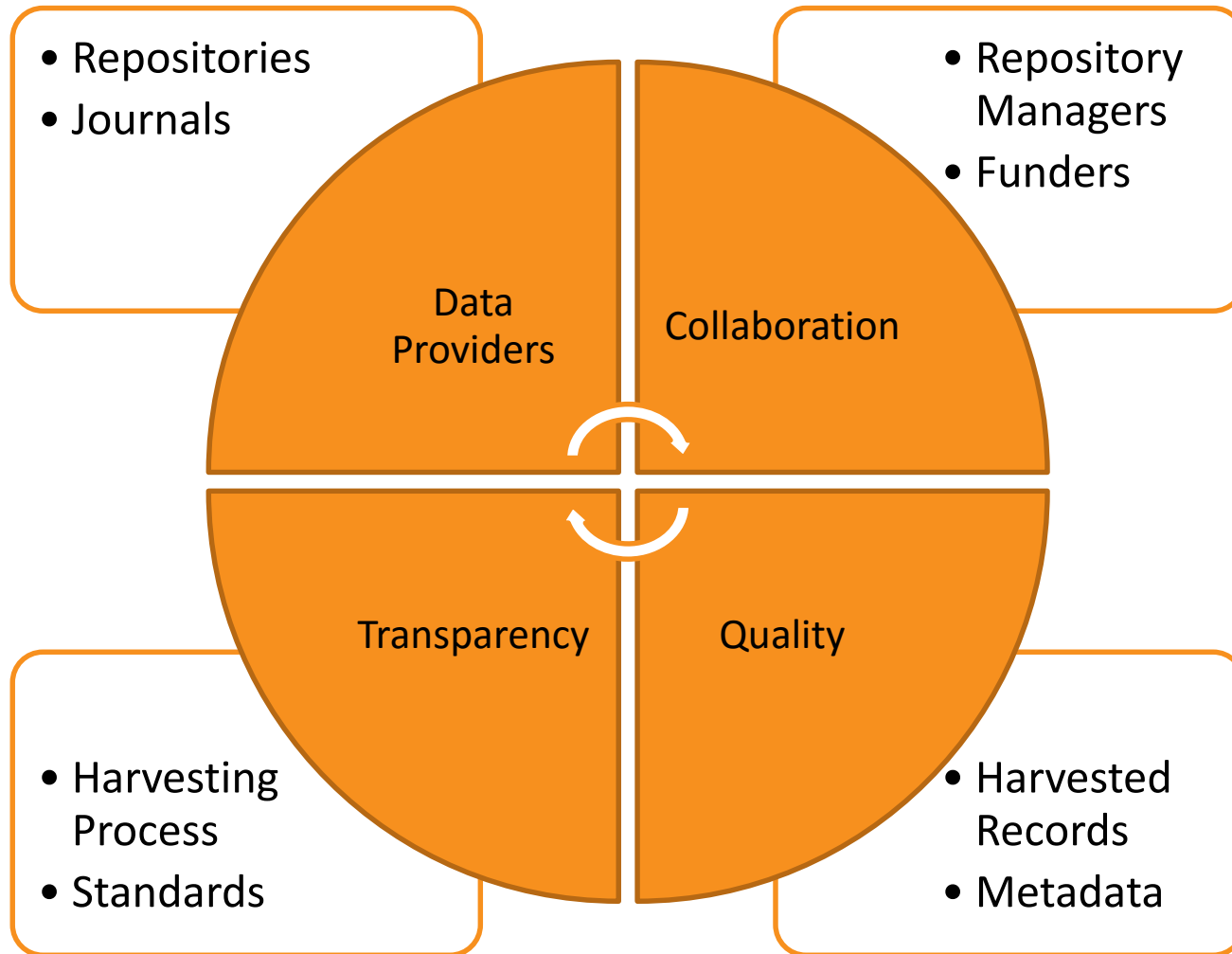

Error
